

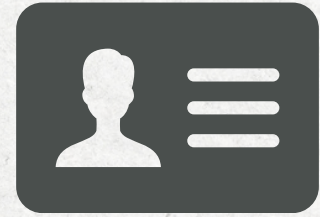
How To Obtain Your Membership Card

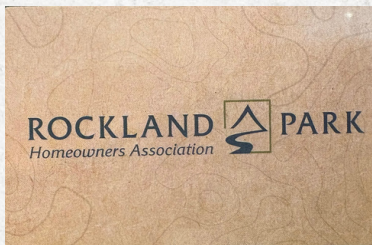


Certificate of Title
or Purchase Agreement



Government Photo ID

If you are the registered owner of the property, bring a copy of your Certificate of Title (or purchase agreement) to the RPHOA office (located at 90 Rowley Way) along with a piece of Government issued photo ID.



- **A membership card is required to gain access to the Rockland Park HOA Lodge & Park.**
- Members must reside in the Rockland Park home to be eligible for a membership card and provide proof of residency in order to obtain a card.
- Each household can be issued up to five (5) membership cards for family members living in the household by default. Requests for additional cards, beyond the allotted five (5), must be approved by the RPHOA management.
- Youth ages 12-17 yrs will issued a membership card once a parent or guardian completes the Children's Waiver Form and presents a birth certificate.



Homeowners renting may choose to transfer privilege's of membership to tenants by completing the transfer of privileges form. Owners or renters (not both) may have park/facility access.



Unmarried children, boarders, and nannies who are 21 years of age or older must provide a piece of Government issued photo ID with the current Rockland Park address on it, to be issued a membership card.



Renters (secondary suite(s)) – Residents in one (1) suite of the home may have access to the RPHOA park/facility with the mandatory membership. If additional suite(s) in the home would like access to the RPHOA park/facility, access for the renters of the additional suite(s) may be purchased for either the Multi Family Rate for the full fiscal year of April 1 - March 31 or \$300 for a 10 Visit Access Pass valid until March 31 of the fiscal year when it was purchased.

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Membership Cards

- A membership card is required to gain access to the RPHOA Facility & Park
- Members must own a property in the Rockland Park HOA boundary to be eligible for a membership card and provide proof of residency in order to obtain a card.
- Youth ages 12-17 yrs will issued a membership card once they present proof of age (birth certificate or passport) they must also be accompanied by a parent/guardian in order to have forms filled out.
- Parents/guardians must get their membership cards first before youth can get theirs.
